
HACK Structure the idiosyncratic infrastructure for adjustable privacy







this phone booth has a kinetic shelter that senses how close one is lean towards it. The shorter the distance, the further it expands to seclude one away from the surrounding.









this is a GPS data carrier used to encrypt one's actual physical location. it comes with the "you are here" map service. to use it, first pinpoint a spot on the map (which also shows the cellular coverage, if you want no GPS data to be sensed at all, choose the place with zero coverage). then tell the carrier the ID of your smart device. the carrier will navigate to the destined location, establishing a relation between your device and its own location. everytime you uses a locative service, the carrier will make its own location appear to others.












this is a robotic street lamp sensitive to infra-red beams. when one sends a beam using their personal devices, the lamp will turn away, thus keeping the person away from being lit.



the hackable spikes, either for birds or human beings, can be extended like an antenna, and rolled out to form a reflective screen. one can broadcast the newspaper they are reading with the mini projector built in their mobile devices.










HACK a Structure
